AN ACT relating to gaming; requiring the State Gaming Control Board to conduct an expedited inspection and investigation of a gaming device under certain circumstances; requiring the Board to charge a fee to conduct such an inspection and investigation; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** NRS 463.670 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 463.670 1. The Legislature finds and declares as facts:
3 (a) That the inspection of gaming devices, associated equipment,
4 cashless wagering systems and interactive gaming systems is
5 essential to carry out the provisions of this chapter; and
6 (b) That inspection of gaming devices, associated equipment,
7 cashless wagering systems and interactive gaming systems is greatly
8 facilitated by the opportunity to inspect components before
9 assembly and to examine the methods of manufacture.
10 2. The Board may inspect every gaming device which is
11 manufactured, sold or distributed:
12 (a) For use in this State, before the gaming device is put into
13 play.
14 (b) In this State for use outside this State, before the gaming
15 device is shipped out of this State.

1 3. The Board may inspect every gaming device which is
2 offered for play within this State by a licensee.

3 4. The Board may inspect all associated equipment, every
4 cashless wagering system and every interactive gaming system
5 which is manufactured, sold or distributed for use in this State
6 before the equipment or system is installed or used by a licensee and
7 at any time while the licensee is using the equipment or system.

8 5. In addition to all other fees and charges imposed by this
9 chapter, the Board may determine, charge and collect an inspection
10 fee from each manufacturer, seller or distributor which must not
11 exceed the actual cost of inspection and investigation.

12 *6. The Board shall, upon the request of a manufacturer of a
13 gaming device, conduct an expedited inspection and investigation
14 of the gaming device of the manufacturer. The Board shall, in
15 addition to any other fee collected by the Board, charge and collect
16 from the manufacturer a fee to conduct the expedited inspection
17 and investigation.*

18 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
