

SENATE BILL NO. 34—COMMITTEE ON TRANSPORTATION
AND HOMELAND SECURITY

(ON BEHALF OF THE DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES)

SUMMARY—Decreases fees for issuance and renewal of noncommercial drivers' licenses. (BDR 43-241)

AN ACT relating to drivers' licenses; decreasing the fees for the issuance and renewal of noncommercial drivers' licenses; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

- 1 Existing law imposes fees of \$14.50 for an original or renewal of a driver's
 - 2 license issued to a person 65 years of age or older and \$19.50 for an original or
 - 3 renewal of a driver's license issued to any other person. (NRS 483.410, 483.415)
 - 4 The revenue from the fees must be deposited in the Motor Vehicle Fund to be used
 - 5 to construct, maintain and repair the public highways in this State. (NRS 483.410;
 - 6 Nev. Const., Art. 9, § 5)
 - 7 This bill would decrease the fee for the issuance or renewal of a driver's license
 - 8 by 50 cents.
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THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** NRS 483.410 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 2 483.410 1. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 6, for
- 3 every driver's license, including a motorcycle driver's license,
- 4 issued and service performed, the following fees must be charged:

13 A new photograph, change of name, change of other
14 information, except address, or any combination 5
15 A duplicate license 14
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17 2. For every motorcycle endorsement to a driver’s license, a
18 fee of \$5 must be charged.

19 3. If no other change is requested or required, the Department
20 shall not charge a fee to convert the number of a license from the
21 licensee’s social security number, or a number that was formulated
22 by using the licensee’s social security number as a basis for the
23 number, to a unique number that is not based on the licensee’s social
24 security number.

25 4. The increase in fees authorized by NRS 483.347 and the fees
26 charged pursuant to NRS 483.383 and 483.415 must be paid in
27 addition to the fees charged pursuant to subsections 1 and 2.

28 5. A penalty of \$10 must be paid by each person renewing his
29 license after it has expired for a period of 30 days or more as
30 provided in NRS 483.386 unless he is exempt pursuant to that
31 section.

32 6. The Department may not charge a fee for the reinstatement
33 of a driver’s license that has been:

- 34 (a) Voluntarily surrendered for medical reasons; or
- 35 (b) Cancelled pursuant to NRS 483.310.

36 7. All fees and penalties are payable to the Administrator at the
37 time a license or a renewal license is issued.

38 8. Except as otherwise provided in NRS 483.340, 483.415 and
39 483.840, all money collected by the Department pursuant to this
40 chapter must be deposited in the State Treasury for credit to the
41 Motor Vehicle Fund.

42 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2005.
