## INTRODUCTION, FIRST READING AND REFERENCE

By Assemblymen Frierson, Monroe-Moreno, Thompson, Yeager, Benitez-Thompson, Jauregui and Swank:

Assembly Bill No. 247—AN ACT relating to the care of children; authorizing the parent or guardian of a child to execute a power of attorney delegating to another person certain powers relating to the child; prohibiting a provider of foster care from providing overnight or regular and continuous care and supervision to a child who is the subject of such a power of attorney under certain circumstances; authorizing an agency which provides child welfare services to provide a referral to or information concerning certain community-based organizations to the parent or guardian of a child who is alleged to be a child in need of protection; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Assemblyman Sprinkle moved that the bill be referred to the Committee on Health and Human Services.

Assembly Bill No. 248—AN ACT relating to settlement agreements; prohibiting settlement agreements from containing provisions that prohibit or restrict a party from disclosing certain information relating to conduct that would qualify as a sexual offense under certain circumstances or discrimination on the basis of sex or a retaliation claim thereof; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.
