SUMMARY—Makes an appropriation to the Legislative Fund for certain members of the Legislative Committee on Public Lands to attend informational meetings and tours in Washington, D.C., during the 2019-2020 interim. (BDR S-508)

AN ACT making an appropriation to the Legislative Fund for the Legislative Committee on Public Lands to attend informational meetings and tours in Washington, D.C., during the 2019-2020 interim; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
2 Fund to the Legislative Fund created by NRS 218A.150 the sum of
3 \$13,980 for five members of the Legislative Committee on Public
4 Lands and one staff member of the Legislative Counsel Bureau to
5 attend informational meetings and tours in Washington, D.C.,
6 during the 2019-2020 interim.
7 **Sec. 2.** The Legislative Commission shall select five members
8 of the Legislative Committee on Public Lands for the 2019-2020
9 interim to attend the informational meetings and tours in
10 Washington, D.C., as follows:



1 1. One member who is an elected officer representing the
2 governing body of a local political subdivision;

3 2. One member from the Assembly who is a member of the
4 Republican Party;

5 3. One member from the Assembly who is a member of the
6 Democratic Party;

7 4. One member from the Senate who is a member of the
8 Republican Party; and

9 5. One member from the Senate who is a member of the
10 Democratic Party.

11 **Sec. 3.** Any remaining balance on the appropriation made by
12 section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after
13 June 30, 2021, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or
14 any entity to which money from the appropriation is granted or
15 otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the
16 appropriated money must not be spent for any purpose after
17 September 17, 2020, by either the entity to which the money was
18 appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently
19 granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General
20 Fund on or before September 17, 2021.

21 **Sec. 4.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2019.
