SUMMARY—Makes an appropriation to the Eighth Judicial District to support the operation of juvenile assessment centers. (BDR S-713)

AN ACT making an appropriation to the Eighth Judicial District to support the operation of juvenile assessment centers; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** (Deleted by amendment.)

2 **Sec. 2.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State
3 General Fund to the Eighth Judicial District of the State of Nevada
4 the sum of \$3,000,000 for:

5 (a) The operation of each juvenile assessment center in the
6 District;

7 (b) The funding of proper mental health professional staff
8 required at each juvenile assessment center in the District;

9 (c) The funding of any portion of support services provided by a
10 juvenile assessment center that is not covered by Medicaid,
11 excluding any services relating to substance abuse; and

12 (d) The funding of regional multidisciplinary prevention teams
13 to provide support services directly to pupils in need of such
14 services at schools throughout the District.

15 2. The money appropriated by subsection 1 must be used to
16 supplement and not supplant or cause to be reduced any other source
17 of funding for the purposes set forth in subsection 1.



1 3. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by
2 subsection 1 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30,
3 2021, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or any entity
4 to which money from the appropriation is granted or otherwise
5 transferred in any manner, and any portion of the appropriated
6 money remaining must not be spent for any purpose after
7 September 17, 2021, by either the entity to which the money was
8 appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently
9 granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General
10 Fund on or before September 17, 2021.

11 4. As used in this section, "juvenile assessment center" means
12 a facility that provides assessments of children for the purpose of
13 determining the needs of a particular child and coordinating
14 appropriate support services to address those needs. The term
15 includes, without limitation, the facility in Clark County known as
16 The Harbor.

17 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
