
SENATE BILL NO. 133—COMMITTEE ON FINANCE

SUMMARY—Makes an appropriation for educational leadership training programs. (BDR S-107)

AN ACT making an appropriation for the implementation and operation of educational leadership training programs; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State
2 General Fund to the Department of Education to contract with the
3 Clark County Public Education Foundation, Inc. for the
4 implementation and operation of educational leadership training
5 programs the following sums:

6 For the Fiscal Year 2019-2020 \$1,000,000
7 For the Fiscal Year 2020-2021 \$1,000,000

8 2. The money appropriated by subsection 1 is contingent upon
9 matching money being provided by the Clark County Public
10 Education Foundation, Inc. or from sources other than the
11 appropriation made by subsection 1. The Department of Education
12 shall not distribute any money from the appropriation made by
13 subsection 1 until the matching money has been committed.

14 **Sec. 2.** 1. The Clark County Public Education Foundation,
15 Inc. shall work in cooperation with the 17 school districts, other
16 public education foundations in this State and other partners to
17 design and implement educational leadership training programs.

18 2. The Clark County Public Education Foundation, Inc. shall
19 use the money it receives from the appropriation made by section 1



1 of this act to implement and operate educational leadership training
2 programs, including, without limitation:

3 (a) Personnel for the programs;

4 (b) Resources necessary to facilitate in-person and virtual
5 instruction;

6 (c) Research related to the design and impact of a curriculum;

7 (d) Communication with education leaders throughout the State;
8 and

9 (e) Data systems for the reporting of participation and results.

10 **Sec. 3.** Upon acceptance of the money appropriated by section
11 1 of this act, the Clark County Public Education Foundation, Inc.
12 agrees to:

13 1. Prepare and transmit a report to the Interim Finance
14 Committee on or before September 18, 2020, that describes each
15 expenditure made from the money appropriated by section 1 of this
16 act from the date on which the money was received by the Clark
17 County Public Education Foundation, Inc. through June 30, 2020;

18 2. Prepare and transmit a final report to the Interim Finance
19 Committee on or before September 17, 2021, that describes each
20 expenditure made from the money appropriated by section 1 of this
21 act from the date on which the money was received by the Clark
22 County Public Education Foundation, Inc. through June 30, 2021;
23 and

24 3. Upon request of the Legislative Commission, make available
25 to the Legislative Auditor any of the books, accounts, claims,
26 reports, vouchers or other records of information, confidential or
27 otherwise, of the Clark County Public Education Foundation, Inc.,
28 regardless of their form or location, that the Legislative Auditor
29 deems necessary to conduct an audit of the use of the money
30 appropriated by section 1 of this act.

31 **Sec. 4.** Any balance of the sums appropriated by section 1 of
32 this act remaining at the end of the respective fiscal years must not
33 be committed for expenditure after June 30 of the respective fiscal
34 years by the entity to which the appropriation is made or any entity
35 to which money from the appropriation is granted or otherwise
36 transferred in any manner, and any portion of the appropriated
37 money remaining must not be spent for any purpose after
38 September 18, 2020, and September 17, 2021, respectively, by
39 either the entity to which the money was appropriated or the entity
40 to which the money was subsequently granted or transferred, and
41 must be reverted to the State General Fund on or before
42 September 18, 2020, and September 17, 2021, respectively.



1 **Sec. 5.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval
2 for the purpose of performing any preparatory administrative tasks
3 necessary to carry out the provisions of this act, and on July 1, 2019,
4 for all other purposes.
