
SENATE BILL NO. 440—SENATORS WASHINGTON AND RATTI

MARCH 25, 2019

Referred to Committee on Finance

SUMMARY—Makes an appropriation to pay certain costs relating to smoke alarms and home fire safety. (BDR S-1134)

AN ACT making an appropriation to the American Red Cross of Nevada to pay certain costs relating to smoke alarms and home fire safety; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State
2 General Fund to the American Red Cross of Nevada the sum of
3 \$300,000 to pay for the costs of providing the following services to
4 residents of Nevada:
- 5 (a) Installation of smoke alarms;
 - 6 (b) Replacement of smoke alarm batteries;
 - 7 (c) Provision of preparedness education relating to home fire
8 safety; and
 - 9 (d) Preparation of customized evacuation plans for home fires
10 and related materials.
- 11 2. Upon acceptance of the money appropriated by subsection 1,
12 the American Red Cross of Nevada agrees to:
- 13 (a) Prepare and transmit a report to the Interim Finance
14 Committee on or before December 18, 2020, that describes each
15 expenditure made from the money appropriated by subsection 1
16 from the date on which the money was received by the American
17 Red Cross of Nevada through December 1, 2020;



1 (b) Prepare and transmit a final report to the Interim Finance
2 Committee on or before September 17, 2021, that describes each
3 expenditure made from the money appropriated by subsection 1
4 from the date on which the money was received by the American
5 Red Cross of Nevada through June 30, 2021; and

6 (c) Upon request of the Legislative Commission, make available
7 to the Legislative Auditor any of the books, accounts, claims,
8 reports, vouchers or other records of information, confidential or
9 otherwise, of the American Red Cross of Nevada, regardless of their
10 form or location, that the Legislative Auditor deems necessary to
11 conduct an audit of the use of the money appropriated pursuant to
12 subsection 1.

13 3. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by
14 subsection 1 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30,
15 2021, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or any entity
16 to which money from the appropriation is granted or otherwise
17 transferred in any manner, and any portion of the appropriated
18 money remaining must not be spent for any purpose after
19 September 17, 2021, by either the entity to which the money was
20 appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently
21 granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General
22 Fund on or before September 17, 2021.

23 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2019.
