# SUMMARY—Makes appropriations relating to certain nonprofit corporations. (BDR S-1164)

AN ACT making appropriations relating to various nonprofit and governmental entities for specified purposes; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

# THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the Interim Finance Committee the sum of \$1,000,000 for allocation pursuant to subsection 2 to the nonprofit corporation formed to relocate the National Atomic Testing Museum in Las Vegas, Nevada, upon a showing to the Committee:

6 (a) That the corporation has been incorporated under the laws of 7 this State as a nonprofit corporation; and

8 (b) That the purpose of the corporation is to relocate the 9 National Atomic Testing Museum in Las Vegas, Nevada.

Allocation of the money appropriated by subsection 1 is 10 2. 11 contingent upon matching money being obtained by the nonprofit corporation described in subsection 1, including, without limitation, 12 gifts, grants and donations to the nonprofit corporation from private 13 and public sources of money other than the appropriation made by 14 subsection 1. The Interim Finance Committee shall not direct the 15 transfer of any portion of money from the appropriation made by 16 subsection 1 until the nonprofit corporation submits to the 17 18 Committee proof satisfactory to the Committee that matching 19 money in an equivalent amount has been committed.





1 3. Upon acceptance of the money allocated pursuant to 2 subsection 2, the nonprofit corporation agrees to:

3 (a) Prepare and transmit a report to the Interim Finance
4 Committee on or before December 18, 2020, that describes each
5 expenditure made from the money allocated pursuant to subsection
6 2 from the date on which the money was received by the nonprofit
7 corporation through December 1, 2020;

(b) Prepare and transmit a final report to the Interim Finance
Committee on or before September 17, 2021, that describes each
expenditure made from the money allocated pursuant to subsection
2 from the date on which the money was received by the nonprofit
corporation through June 30, 2021; and

13 (c) Upon request of the Legislative Commission, make available 14 to the Legislative Auditor any of the books, accounts, claims, 15 reports, vouchers or other records of information, confidential or 16 otherwise, of the nonprofit corporation, regardless of their form or 17 location, that the Legislative Auditor deems necessary to conduct an 18 audit of the use of the money allocated pursuant to subsection 2.

19 4. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by 20 subsection 1 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 21 2021, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or any entity to which money from the appropriation is granted or 22 23 otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the 24 appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose 25 after September 17, 2021, by either the entity to which the money 26 was appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently 27 granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General 28 Fund on or before September 17, 2021.

**Sec. 2.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the Reno Rodeo Association the sum of \$1,000,000 for the advance planning and schematic design phases on a master plan to rehabilitate, repair, renovate and improve the Reno-Sparks Livestock Events Center.

2. Upon acceptance of the money appropriated by subsection 1,the Reno Rodeo Association agrees to:

(a) Prepare and transmit a report to the Interim Finance
Committee on or before December 18, 2020, that describes each
expenditure made from the money appropriated by subsection 1
from the date on which the money was received by the Reno Rodeo
Association through December 1, 2020;

(b) Prepare and transmit a final report to the Interim Finance
Committee on or before September 17, 2021, that describes each
expenditure made from the money appropriated by subsection 1
from the date on which the money was received by Reno Rodeo
Association through June 30, 2021; and





1 (c) Upon request of the Legislative Commission, make available 2 to the Legislative Auditor any of the books, accounts, claims, 3 reports, vouchers or other records of information, confidential or 4 otherwise, of the Reno Rodeo Association, regardless of their form 5 or location, that the Legislative Auditor deems necessary to conduct 6 an audit of the use of the money appropriated by subsection 1.

7 Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by 3. 8 subsection 1 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 9 2021, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or any 10 entity to which money from the appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the 11 12 appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose after September 17, 2021, by either the entity to which the money 13 14 was appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently 15 granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General 16 Fund on or before September 17, 2021.

**Sec. 3.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the Interim Finance Committee the sum of \$500,000 for allocation to the International Gaming Institute of the William F. Harrah College of Hotel Administration of the University of Nevada, Las Vegas for the Leaderverse Initiative to increase the diversity of leaders in the gaming industry.

23 Allocation of the money appropriated by subsection 1 is 2. 24 upon matching money being obtained by the contingent 25 International Gaming Institute, including, without limitation, gifts, 26 grants and donations to the International Gaming Institute from 27 private and public sources of money other than the appropriation 28 made by subsection 1. The Interim Finance Committee shall not 29 direct the transfer of any portion of money from the appropriation 30 made by subsection 1 until the International Gaming Institute 31 submits to the Committee proof satisfactory to the Committee that 32 matching money in an equivalent amount has been committed.

33 3. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by 34 subsection 1 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 35 2021, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or any 36 entity to which money from the appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the 37 38 appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose after September 17, 2021, by either the entity to which the money 39 40 was appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General 41 42 Fund on or before September 17, 2021.

43 **Sec. 4.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State 44 General Fund to the Nevada State Museum, Las Vegas the sum of





\$3,000,000 to provide a grant of money to the Springs Preserve
 Foundation to be used for the purposes set forth in subsection 2.

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2. The Springs Preserve Foundation shall use:

4 (a) Not more than \$1,000,000 of the grant provided pursuant to 5 subsection 1 for the renovation of the Sustainability Gallery to 6 relocate the Nature Gallery and develop classroom and indoor play 7 spaces for children.

(b) Not more than \$2,000,000 of the grant provided pursuant to
subsection 1 for the design of the Science and Sustainability Center
to expand exhibit space and construct a large classroom facility.

11 3. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by 12 subsection 1 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2021, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or any 13 14 entity to which money from the appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the 15 16 appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose after September 17, 2021, by either the entity to which the money 17 18 was appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently 19 granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General 20 Fund on or before September 17, 2021.

21 **Sec. 5.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State 22 General Fund to Vegas PBS the sum of \$709,150 for the production 23 of episodes and related educational curriculum for the Outdoor 24 Nevada television series.

25 2. Upon acceptance of the money appropriated by subsection 1,
26 Vegas PBS agrees to:

(a) Prepare and transmit a report to the Interim Finance
Committee on or before December 18, 2020, that describes each
expenditure made from the money appropriated by subsection 1
from the date on which the money was received by Vegas PBS
through December 1, 2020;

(b) Prepare and transmit a final report to the Interim Finance
Committee on or before September 17, 2021, that describes each
expenditure made from the money appropriated by subsection 1
from the date on which the money was received by Vegas PBS
through June 30, 2021; and

(c) Upon request of the Legislative Commission, make available
to the Legislative Auditor any of the books, accounts, claims,
reports, vouchers or other records of information, confidential or
otherwise, of Vegas PBS, regardless of their form or location, that
the Legislative Auditor deems necessary to conduct an audit of the
use of the money appropriated by subsection 1.

44 subsection 1 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30,
45 2021, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or any





entity to which money from the appropriation is granted or
 otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the

 was appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently
 granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General
 Fund on or before September 17, 2021.
 Sec. 6. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.

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
