AN ACT making a supplemental appropriation to the Nevada Highway Patrol for an unanticipated shortfall in gasoline costs; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State  
2 Highway Fund to the Nevada Highway Patrol Division of the  
3 Department of Public Safety the sum of \$441,225 for an  
4 unanticipated shortfall in gasoline costs. This appropriation is  
5 supplemental to that made by section 30 of chapter 396, Statutes of  
6 Nevada 2017, at page 2641.

7     **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
