
SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 4—SENATOR CANNIZZARO

MARCH 25, 2019

Read and Adopted

SUMMARY—Amends the Standing Rules of the Senate for the 80th Session of the Legislature. (BDR R-1256)

SENATE RESOLUTION—Amending the Standing Rules of the Senate for the 80th Session of the Legislature to revise the number of members on the Committee on Commerce and Labor.

1 RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, That
2 Rule No. 40 of the Standing Rules of the Senate as adopted by the
3 80th Session of the Legislature is hereby amended to read as
4 follows:

5 Rule No. 40. Standing and Select Committees.

6 1. The Majority Leader shall determine the majority-
7 minority party composition of all standing and select
8 committees. Appointments to committees shall be made by
9 the Majority Leader for the majority party members and by
10 the Minority Leader for the minority party members. The
11 Majority Leader shall designate the Chair and Vice Chair of
12 all standing and select committees.

13 2. The Majority Leader shall refer prefiled bills and
14 resolutions to committee, subject to ratification by a majority
15 vote of the Senate once the Senate is organized and ready for
16 business.

17 3. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 4, the
18 standing and select committees of the Senate and their
19 respective jurisdiction for the reference of bills and
20 resolutions are as follows:

21 (a) Commerce and Labor, ~~eight~~ *seven* members, with
22 jurisdiction over measures affecting primarily titles 52-56 of
23 NRS, and chapters 97-100, 118-119, 119B, 461, 461A, 489,



1 679A-693A, 694A-697, 711 and 712 of NRS, except
2 measures affecting primarily state and local revenue.

3 (b) Education, seven members, with jurisdiction over
4 measures affecting primarily chapters 353B, 378-380A, 385-
5 386 and 388-399 of NRS, except measures affecting
6 primarily state and local revenue.

7 (c) Finance, eight members, with jurisdiction over
8 measures affecting primarily chapters 1A, 387 and 400 of
9 NRS, appropriations, operating and capital budgets, state and
10 federal budget issues and bonding, except measures affecting
11 primarily state and local revenue, and over any measures
12 carrying or requiring appropriations and favorably reported
13 by any other committee.

14 (d) Government Affairs, five members, with jurisdiction
15 over measures affecting primarily titles 20, 21, 25, 27, 28, 30,
16 36 and 37 of NRS, and chapters 223-228, 232-233I, 234-237,
17 238-242, 271, 277-280, 286-289, 353, 353A, 353C-358, 381,
18 384, 472-474, 477, 693B, 709, 710 and 720 of NRS, except
19 measures affecting primarily the provisions of the Nevada
20 Administrative Procedure Act that govern the adjudication of
21 contested cases, the Tahoe Regional Planning Compact and
22 the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency, state and local revenue
23 and state and federal budget issues.

24 (e) Growth and Infrastructure, eight members, with
25 jurisdiction over measures affecting primarily title 44 of
26 NRS, and chapters 403-405, 408, 410, 459A, 476, 480-487,
27 490 and 701-708 of NRS, except measures affecting
28 primarily state and local revenue.

29 (f) Health and Human Services, five members, with
30 jurisdiction over measures affecting primarily titles 38 and 39
31 of NRS, chapters 439-442 of NRS, NRS 444.002-444.430
32 and chapters 446-453C, 454-458A, 460 and 583-585 of NRS,
33 except measures affecting primarily state and local revenue.

34 (g) Judiciary, eight members, with jurisdiction over
35 measures affecting primarily the provisions of the Nevada
36 Administrative Procedure Act that govern the adjudication of
37 contested cases, titles 2-7, 9, 11-16 and 41 of NRS, and
38 chapters 1, 2-7, 101-104A, 111-117, 119A, 120, 120A, 475,
39 719, 721 and 722 of NRS, except measures affecting
40 primarily state and local revenue.

41 (h) Legislative Operations and Elections, five members,
42 with jurisdiction over measures affecting primarily titles 17,
43 24 and 29 of NRS, chapters 281-285 of NRS, and the
44 operation of the legislative session, except measures affecting
45 primarily state and local revenue.



1 (i) Natural Resources, five members, with jurisdiction
2 over measures affecting primarily titles 26 and 45-50 of NRS,
3 chapters 383 and 407 of NRS, NRS 444.435-444.650,
4 chapters 444A-445D, 459, 488, 581, 582 and 586-590 of
5 NRS, and the Tahoe Regional Planning Compact and the
6 Tahoe Regional Planning Agency, except measures affecting
7 primarily state and local revenue.

8 (j) Revenue and Economic Development, five members,
9 with jurisdiction over measures affecting primarily title 32 of
10 NRS, chapters 231, 231A, 237A, 271A-274 and 453D of
11 NRS, and state and local revenue.

12 4. The Chair of the Standing Committee on Finance may
13 assign any portion of a proposed executive budget to any of
14 the other standing or select committees of the Senate for
15 review. Upon receiving such an assignment the standing or
16 select committee shall complete its review expeditiously and
17 report its findings and any recommendations to the Standing
18 Committee on Finance for its independent evaluation.

20 RESOLVED, That this resolution becomes effective upon
21 passage.
