SUMMARY—Revises provisions governing license plate decals. (BDR 43-985)

FISCAL NOTE: Effect on Local Government: No. Effect on the State: No.

EXPLANATION - Matter in *bolded italics* is new; matter between brackets [omitted material] is material to be omitted.

AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; removing provisions governing the issuance and display of license plate decals evidencing the current registration of a motor vehicle; removing the requirement for a license plate to display the month and year the vehicle registration expires; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

Existing law requires every motor vehicle license plate to have displayed on it: (1) the year the registration of the motor vehicle expires, if issued for the calendar year; or (2) the month and year the registration of the motor vehicle expires, if issued for a registration period other than a calendar year. (NRS 482.270) Existing law authorizes the Department of Motor Vehicles, upon renewal of registration, to issue one or more license plate stickers, tabs or other suitable devices in lieu of new license plates. (NRS 482.265) Section 5 of this bill provides that the license plates issued by the Department are not required to display the year or the month and year, as applicable, that the registration expires. Section 4 of this bill removes the authorization for the Department to issue license plate stickers, tabs or other suitable devices in lieu of new license plates.

Existing law requires the Department to issue a permanent license plate decal to a short-term lessor of vehicles who registers through the fleet registration program established by the Department for such lessors. (NRS 482.2085) Section 2 of this bill removes the requirement for the Department to issue a permanent license plate decal.

17 Existing law requires a person to whom any license plate decal is issued to 18 immediately make application for and obtain a substitute decal if the decal is lost, 19 mutilated, illegible or stolen. (NRS 482.285) **Section 9** of this bill removes this 20 requirement.

21 Sections 3, 6-8 and 10-25 of this bill remove references to the issuance and display of license plate registration decals, stickers and tabs.





THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 NRS 482.206 is hereby amended to read as follows: Section 1. 2 482.206 1. Except as otherwise provided in this section and 3 NRS 482.2065 and 482.2085, every motor vehicle, except for a 4 motor vehicle that is required to be registered through the Motor Carrier Division of the Department, and except for a full trailer or 5 semitrailer that is registered pursuant to subsection 3 of NRS 6 7 482.483 or a moped registered pursuant to NRS 482.2155, must be 8 registered for a period of 12 consecutive months beginning the day 9 after the first registration by the owner in this State.

Except as otherwise provided in subsections 7 and 8 and 11 NRS 482.2065, every vehicle registered by an agent of the 12 Department or a registered dealer must be registered for 12 13 consecutive months beginning the first day of the month after the 14 first registration by the owner in this State.

15 3. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 7 and NRS 16 482.2065 and 482.2085, a motor vehicle which must be registered 17 through the Motor Carrier Division of the Department, including, 18 without limitation:

(a) Pursuant to the provisions of NRS 706.801 to 706.861,inclusive; or

(b) As a commercial motor vehicle which has a declared grossweight in excess of 10,000 pounds,

23 \rightarrow must be registered for a period of 12 consecutive months 24 beginning on the date established by the Department by regulation.

4. Upon the application of the owner of a fleet of vehicles which are not required to be registered through the Motor Carrier Division of the Department, the Director may permit the owner to register the fleet on the basis of a calendar year.

5. Except as otherwise provided in subsections 3, 6, 7 and 8, when the registration of any vehicle is transferred pursuant to NRS 482.399, the expiration date of each regular license plate [,] or special license plate [or substitute decal] must, at the time of the transfer of registration, be advanced for a period of 12 consecutive months beginning:

(a) The first day of the month after the transfer, if the vehicle is
 transferred by an agent of the Department; or

37 (b) The day after the transfer in all other cases,

 \Rightarrow and a credit on the portion of the fee for registration and the governmental services tax attributable to the remainder of the current period of registration must be allowed pursuant to the applicable provisions of NRS 482.399.

When the registration of any trailer that is registered for a 3-2 year period pursuant to NRS 482.2065 is transferred pursuant to 3 NRS 482.399, the expiration date of each license plate for substitute decal] must, at the time of the transfer of the registration, be 4 5 advanced, if applicable pursuant to NRS 482.2065, for a period of 3 6 consecutive years beginning:

(a) The first day of the month after the transfer, if the trailer is 7 8 transferred by an agent of the Department; or 9

(b) The day after the transfer in all other cases,

→ and a credit on the portion of the fee for registration and the 10 governmental services tax attributable to the remainder of 11 12 the current period of registration must be allowed pursuant to the 13 applicable provisions of NRS 482.399.

14 7. A full trailer or semitrailer that is registered pursuant to 15 subsection 3 of NRS 482.483 is registered until the date on which 16 the owner of the full trailer or semitrailer:

(a) Transfers the ownership of the full trailer or semitrailer; or

18 (b) Cancels the registration of the full trailer or semitrailer and 19 surrenders the license plates to the Department.

20 A moped that is registered pursuant to NRS 482.2155 is 8. 21 registered until the date on which the owner of the moped:

(a) Transfers the ownership of the moped; or

23 (b) Cancels the registration of the moped and surrenders the 24 license plate to the Department.

Sec. 2. NRS 482.2085 is hereby amended to read as follows:

26 482.2085 The Department shall establish a vehicle 1. 27 registration program for short-term lessors that have a fleet of 28 vehicles registered in this State to allow the short-term lessors which 29 satisfy the requirements for eligibility established by the Department 30 to submit to the Department:

31 (a) Applications for initial registration of vehicles added to the 32 fleet, which must include, without limitation, the information 33 required by NRS 482.295.

(b) Applications for the renewal of the registration of vehicles in 34 35 the fleet, including, without limitation, the information required by 36 NRS 482.295.

A certificate of registration [and decal] issued pursuant to 5 this section [are] *is* valid for the vehicle until the vehicle is no longer 6 a part of the fleet of the short-term lessor, unless the short-term 7 lessor fails to renew the registration. [The short term lessor must not 8 be required to display on the license plate of a vehicle registered 9 pursuant to this section the month and year on which the registration 10 expires.]

4. The Department shall provide to a short-term lessor that participates in the program established pursuant to subsection 1 electronic notice of the required renewal of registration for a vehicle in the fleet, which must be sent at least 30 days before payment is due. Notification sent pursuant to this subsection must include the information required pursuant to subsection 3 of NRS 482.280 for other renewals.

18 5. A short-term lessor that participates in the program 19 established pursuant to subsection 1 must:

20 (a) Pay annually the renewal fees and governmental services 21 taxes required for each fleet vehicle registered in this State.

22 (b) Upon removing a vehicle from the fleet, notify the 23 Department.

6. Any vehicle having a declared gross weight in excess of 25 26,000 pounds is not eligible to be registered as part of a fleet 26 pursuant to this section.

7. The Department shall adopt regulations necessary to carry

without limitation, the number of vehicles that a short-term lessor
must possess as part of the fleet to participate in the program.

15 (c) The Department shall not design, prepare or issue a special 16 license plate unless, within 4 years after the date on which the 17 measure authorizing the issuance becomes effective, it receives at least 250 applications for the issuance of that plate. 18

19 The provisions of subsection 4 do not apply 5. to 20 NRS 482.37901.

Sec. 5. NRS 482.270 is hereby amended to read as follows:

22 482.270 1. Except as otherwise provided in this section or by specific statute, the Director shall order the redesign and preparation 23 24 of motor vehicle license plates.

25 2. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 3, the 26 Department may, upon the payment of all applicable fees, issue 27 redesigned motor vehicle license plates.

44 (a) The registration number, or combination of letters and 45 numbers, assigned to the vehicle and to the owner thereof; and





1 (b) The name of this State, which may be abbreviated.

2 (c) If issued for a calendar year, the year; and

(d) Except as otherwise provided in NRS 482.2085, if issued for 3 4 a registration period other than a calendar year, the month and year 5 the registration expires.]

6 6. Each special license plate that is designed, prepared and 7 issued pursuant to NRS 482.367002 must be designed and prepared 8 in such a manner that:

9 (a) The left-hand one-third of the plate is the only part of the plate on which is displayed any design or other insignia that is 10 suggested pursuant to paragraph (g) of subsection 2 of that section; 11 12 and

13 (b) The remainder of the plate conforms to the requirements for 14 lettering and design that are set forth in this section.

15 7. A license plate produced pursuant to this section is not 16 required to have displayed upon it the year or the month and year 17 the registration expires. 18

Sec. 6. NRS 482.2705 is hereby amended to read as follows:

19 482.2705 1. The Director shall order the preparation of 20 vehicle license plates for passenger cars and trucks in the same 21 manner as is provided for motor vehicles generally in NRS 482.270.

22 Except as otherwise provided by specific statute, the 2. 23 Director shall determine the combinations of letters and numbers 24 which constitute the designations for license plates assigned to 25 passenger cars and trucks.

26 Any license plate issued for a passenger car or truck before 3. 27 January 1, 1982, bearing a designation which is not in conformance 28 with the system described in subsection 2 is:

29 (a) Valid during the period for which the plate was originally issued as well as during any extensions; [by stickers;] and 30

31 (b) Not subject to reissue pursuant to subsection 2 of NRS 482.265. 32

33 **Sec. 7.** NRS 482.274 is hereby amended to read as follows:

34 482.274 1. The Director shall order the preparation of vehicle 35 license plates for trailers in the same manner provided for motor 36 vehicles in NRS 482.270. [, except that a vehicle license plate 37 prepared for a full trailer or semitrailer that is registered pursuant to 38 subsection 3 of NRS 482.483 is not required to have displayed upon 39 it the month and year the registration expires.]

40 2. The Director shall order preparation of two sizes of vehicle license plates for trailers. The smaller plates may be used for trailers 41 42 with a gross vehicle weight of less than 1,000 pounds.

 vehicle or trailer, regardless of size, weight or year of manufacture,
 that was manufactured for use in the military forces of any country
 and is maintained to depict or represent military design or markings.
 The term includes, without limitation, armored vehicles, passenger
 cars, half-track vehicles, motorcycles, pick-up trucks, sport utility
 vehicles, tracked vehicles, trailers, trucks and truck-tractors.

8 **Sec. 25.** NRS 485.320 is hereby amended to read as follows: 9 485.320 1. If the license of any person is suspended as 10 provided in this chapter, the person shall immediately return the 11 license to the Department. If the person's registration is suspended,

the person shall immediately return the certificate of registration and
 the license plates to the Department.

14 2. If any person fails to return any item as required by 15 subsection 1, the Department shall forthwith direct any peace officer 16 to secure possession thereof and to return the item to the 17 Department.

A person who owns a dormant vehicle who desires to cancel
the policy of liability insurance covering that vehicle or to allow
such a policy to expire:

(a) Shall, on or before the date on which the policy is cancelled
or expires, cancel the registration of the vehicle to which that policy
pertains.

(b) May [, if the person presents the license plates for that
vehicle to the authorized personnel of the Department for the
removal and destruction of the sticker or other device evidencing the
current registration of the vehicle,] retain for potential reinstatement
the license plates for a period not to exceed 1 year.

4. The Department shall adopt regulations which define wetended period," "mechanical circumstances" and "seasonal circumstances" for the purposes of NRS 485.0335.
