AN ACT making an appropriation to the Department of Veterans Services to provide financial assistance and support for the Adopt a Vet Dental Program; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General  
2 Fund to the Department of Veterans Services to provide financial  
3 assistance and support for the Adopt a Vet Dental Program the  
4 following sums:

5 For the Fiscal Year 2021-2022 ..... \$250,000  
6 For the Fiscal Year 2022-2023 ..... \$250,000

7 **Sec. 2.** Any balance of the sums appropriated by section 1 of  
8 this act remaining at the end of the respective fiscal years must not  
9 be committed for expenditure after June 30 of the respective fiscal  
10 years by the entity to which the appropriation is made or any entity  
11 to which money from the appropriation is granted or otherwise  
12 transferred in any manner, and any portion of the appropriated  
13 money remaining must not be spent for any purpose after



1 September 16, 2022, and September 15, 2023, respectively, by  
2 either the entity to which the money was appropriated or the entity  
3 to which the money was subsequently granted or transferred, and  
4 must be reverted to the State General Fund on or before  
5 September 16, 2022, and September 15, 2023, respectively.

6 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2021.
