SUMMARY—Revises provisions relating to public employment. (BDR 23-629)

AN ACT relating to public employment; requiring certain public employers to provide certain training to employees regarding the Public Employees' Retirement System; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

Under existing law, public employers are required, with certain exceptions, to participate in the Public Employees' Retirement System and their employees are required to be members of the System. (NRS 286.290) Section 1 of this bill requires public employers participating in the System to provide certain training to each of its employees who is a member of the System before the completion of the employee's first year of employment. Section 1 requires the training to be structured to ensure that the employee obtains an understanding of the System and provides an explanation to the employee of: (1) the retirement benefits that the employee is anticipated to receive from the System; (2) the vesting of the employee's benefits; (3) the amount of the contributions to the System paid by the public employer on behalf of the employee and, if applicable, the amount of the contributions that the employee is required to pay to the System, and (4) any additional information requested by the employee relating to the System. Section 2 of this bill requires, under certain circumstances, a public employer to provide this training to an employee who began his or her employment with the public employer before July 1, 2022.





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THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Chapter 286 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

1. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 2, each public employer participating in the System shall provide the training required by this section to each of its employees who is a member of the System before the completion of the employee's first year of employment with the public employer. The training:

(a) Must be structured to ensure that the employee obtains an understanding of the System and provides an explanation of:

(1) The retirement benefits that the employee is anticipated to receive from the System, including, without limitation, an explanation of how to calculate the employee's projected monthly service retirement allowance and any projected increases in postretirement benefits;

(2) The vesting of the employee's retirement benefits;

- (3) The amount of the contributions to the System made by the employer on behalf of the employee and, if applicable, the amount of the contributions that the employee is required to pay to the System; and
- (4) Any additional information requested by the employee relating to the System.
 - (b) May be conducted in person or online.
 - (c) Must be provided at no cost to the employee.
- 2. The requirement to provide the training described in subsection 1 before the completion of the employee's first year of employment may be extended for a reasonable period of time if there is an emergency or disaster that affects the operation of the public employer such that providing the training within the employee's first year of employment is impracticable.
- 3. A public employer shall provide the training required by subsection 1 regardless of whether the employee received the training from a previous public employer.
- **Sec. 2.** 1. A public employer shall provide the training described in section 1 of this act to an employee who began his or her employment with the public employer before July 1, 2022, if the public employee requests the training. Such training must be provided by the public employer within a reasonable period of time after receiving the request from the employee.
 - 2. As used in this section:
 - (a) "Employee" has the meaning ascribed to it in NRS 286.040.
- (b) "Public employer" has the meaning ascribed to it in NRS 286.070.



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- **Sec. 3.** The provisions of NRS 354.599 do not apply to any additional expenses of a local government that are related to the provisions of this act.
- **Sec. 4.** 1. This section becomes effective upon passage and approval.
 - 2. Sections 1, 2 and 3 of this act become effective:
- (a) Upon passage and approval for the purpose of performing any preparatory administrative tasks that are necessary to carry out the provisions of this act; and
 - (b) On July 1, 2022, for all other purposes.





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
