SUMMARY—Makes an appropriation to and authorizes the expenditure of money by the Commission on Ethics for the replacement of computer hardware and associated software. (BDR S-1139)

AN ACT making an appropriation to and authorizing the expenditure of money by the Commission on Ethics for the replacement of computer hardware and associated software; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

# THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State 2 General Fund to the Commission on Ethics the sum of \$3,359 for 3 the replacement of computer hardware and associated software.

4 2. Expenditure of \$8,621 not appropriated from the State 5 General Fund or State Highway Fund is hereby authorized during 6 Fiscal Year 2023-2024 and Fiscal Year 2024-2025 by the 7 Commission on Ethics for the same purpose as set forth in 8 subsection 1.

9 3. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by 10 subsection 1 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 11 2025, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or any entity 12 to which money from the appropriation is granted or otherwise





transferred in any manner, and any portion of the appropriated
money remaining must not be spent for any purpose after
September 19, 2025, by either the entity to which the money was
appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently
granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General
Fund on or before September 19, 2025.

7 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
