THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1     **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State
- 2     General Fund to the Commission on Ethics the sum of \$3,359 for
- 3     the replacement of computer hardware and associated software.
- 4     2. Expenditure of \$8,621 not appropriated from the State
- 5     General Fund or State Highway Fund is hereby authorized during
- 6     Fiscal Year 2023-2024 and Fiscal Year 2024-2025 by the
- 7     Commission on Ethics for the same purpose as set forth in
- 8     subsection 1.
- 9     3. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by
- 10    subsection 1 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30,
- 11    2025, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or any entity
- 12    to which money from the appropriation is granted or otherwise



1 transferred in any manner, and any portion of the appropriated  
2 money remaining must not be spent for any purpose after  
3 September 19, 2025, by either the entity to which the money was  
4 appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently  
5 granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General  
6 Fund on or before September 19, 2025.

7 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
