AN ACT making appropriations to the Nevada System of Higher Education for the renewal of certain technology leases and the replacement of certain technological equipment; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
2 Fund to the Nevada System of Higher Education the sum of
3 \$3,000,000 for the System Computing Center budget account for the
4 renewal of dark fiber leases for NevadaNet.

5 **Sec. 2.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
6 Fund to the Nevada System of Higher Education the sum of
7 \$5,000,000 for the System Computing Center budget account for the
8 replacement of equipment that supports NevadaNet.

9 **Sec. 3.** Any remaining balance of the appropriations made by
10 sections 1 and 2 of this act must not be committed for expenditure
11 after June 30, 2025, by the entity to which the appropriation is made
12 or any entity to which money from the appropriation is granted or
13 otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the
14 appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose



1 after September 19, 2025, by either the entity to which the money
2 was appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently
3 granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General
4 Fund on or before September 19, 2025.

5 **Sec. 4.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
