ASSEMBLY CONCURRENT RESOLUTION—Granting administrative leave to legislative employees in recognition of their service to the 82nd Session of the Nevada Legislature.

1 WHEREAS, The staff of the Nevada Legislature and the  
2 Administrative, Audit, Fiscal Analysis, Legal and Research  
3 Divisions of the Legislative Counsel Bureau provide services to the  
4 Legislature which are vital to an efficient and productive session of  
5 the Nevada Legislature; and

6 WHEREAS, The additional employees hired specifically for the  
7 legislative session also provide essential services with dedication,  
8 competence and enthusiasm throughout the long days of the session;  
9 and

10 WHEREAS, Extraordinary demands are routinely placed on  
11 legislative employees as a result of the time constraints of the 120-  
12 day limitation on the length of the legislative session, and the entire  
13 legislative staff has demonstrated their amazing work ethic and  
14 ability to overcome obstacles, meet deadlines, assist legislators,  
15 exhibit patience, flexibility and dedication; and

16 WHEREAS, Former Assemblyman Bob Price and Former Senator  
17 Debbie Smith had a tradition of introducing legislation to allow the  
18 Legislature to recognize the hard work and dedication of legislative  
19 employees by granting administrative leave following each  
20 legislative session; and

21 WHEREAS, In keeping with that tradition, the members of the  
22 82nd session of the Nevada Legislature do hereby recognize and



1 express their sincere gratitude for the outstanding effort made by the  
2 permanent employees of the Legislature and Legislative Counsel  
3 Bureau and by all other employees hired temporarily for the  
4 legislative session; now, therefore, be it

5 RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, THE  
6 SENATE CONCURRING, That 5 days of administrative leave are  
7 hereby granted to each:

8 1. Permanent employee of the Legislature and Legislative  
9 Counsel Bureau who is employed on the last day of session; and

10 2. Employee of the Legislature and Legislative Counsel Bureau  
11 hired temporarily for the legislative session who:

12 (a) Is employed by the Legislature or Legislative Counsel  
13 Bureau on the last day of this session; and

14 (b) If requested to do so by the employee's supervisor, remains  
15 in that employment after the last day of this session until all tasks  
16 assigned to the employee during the session are completed; and be it  
17 further

18 RESOLVED, That this resolution becomes effective upon  
19 adoption.
