(BDR S-1128)

AN ACT making appropriations to the ~~Communication and Computing Unit of the Division of Enterprise Information Technology Services of the Department of Administration~~ Office of Finance in the Office of the Governor as loans for the replacement of computer hardware and associated software, the replacement of components of a security firewall and security upgrades to mountaintop microwave sites; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1. 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to

51 ~~Sec. 7. Any remaining balance of the appropriations made by sections 1 [to] ,~~
52 ~~3 and 6 [inclusive] of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June~~
53 ~~30, 2025, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or any entity to which~~

1 money from the appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in any manner,
2 and any portion of the appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any
3 purpose after September 19, 2025, by either the entity to which the money was
4 appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently granted or
5 transferred, and must be reverted to the State General Fund on or before September
6 19, 2025.

7 **Sec. 8.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
