
SENATE BILL NO. 219—SENATORS KRASNER, FLORES, SEEVERS
GANSERT, SPEARMAN, OHRENSCHALL; AND LANGE

SUMMARY—Makes an appropriation to Special Olympics of Nevada to establish the organization as an independent nonprofit entity and expand its programs in this State. (BDR S-547)

AN ACT making an appropriation to Special Olympics of Nevada to establish the organization as an independent nonprofit entity in Nevada and for the expansion of its programs for people with disabilities; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State
2 General Fund to Special Olympics of Nevada for the establishment
3 of the organization as an independent nonprofit entity in Nevada and
4 expanding the organization’s programs in the areas of health,
5 education, leadership, development and sports for people with
6 disabilities the following sums:
7 For the Fiscal Year 2023-2024 \$250,000
8 For the Fiscal Year 2024-2025 \$250,000
9 2. Upon acceptance of the money appropriated by subsection 1,
10 Special Olympics of Nevada agrees to:
11 (a) Prepare and transmit a report to the Interim Finance
12 Committee on or before December 20, 2024, that describes each
13 expenditure made from the money appropriated by subsection 1



1 from the date on which the money was received by Special
2 Olympics of Nevada through December 1, 2024;

3 (b) Prepare and transmit a final report to the Interim Finance
4 Committee on or before September 19, 2025, that describes each
5 expenditure made from the money appropriated by subsection 1
6 from the date on which the money was received by Special
7 Olympics of Nevada through June 30, 2025; and

8 (c) Upon request of the Legislative Commission, make available
9 to the Legislative Auditor any of the books, accounts, claims,
10 reports, vouchers or other records of information, confidential or
11 otherwise, of Special Olympics of Nevada, regardless of their form
12 or location, that the Legislative Auditor deems necessary to conduct
13 an audit of the use of the money appropriated pursuant to
14 subsection 1.

15 3. The sums appropriated by subsection 1 are available for
16 either fiscal year. Any remaining balance of those sums must not be
17 committed for expenditure after June 30, 2025, by the entity to
18 which the appropriation is made or any entity to which money from
19 the appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in any manner,
20 and any portion of the appropriated money remaining must not be
21 spent for any purpose after September 19, 2025, by either the entity
22 to which the money was appropriated or the entity to which the
23 money was subsequently granted or transferred, and must be
24 reverted to the State General Fund on or before September 19, 2025.

25 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
