SUMMARY—Makes appropriations to the Office of the Governor for the replacement of certain equipment and computer hardware and associated software and licenses to upgrade a computer operating system. (BDR S-1109)

AN ACT making appropriations to the Office of the Governor for the replacement of certain equipment and computer hardware and associated software and licenses to upgrade a computer operating system; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1     **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
- 2 Fund to the Office of the Governor the sum of \$10,100 for the
- 3 Governor’s Mansion budget account for the replacement of
- 4 commercial kitchen equipment.
- 5     **Sec. 2.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
- 6 Fund to the Office for New Americans in the Office of the Governor
- 7 the sum of \$3,976 for the replacement of computer hardware and
- 8 associated software.
- 9     **Sec. 3.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
- 10 Fund to the Office of Federal Assistance in the Office of the



1 Governor the sum of \$6,453 for the replacement of computer  
2 hardware and associated software.

3 **Sec. 4.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General  
4 Fund to the Agency for Nuclear Projects in the Office of the  
5 Governor the sum of \$6,192 for the replacement of a computer  
6 server and the costs of licenses to upgrade the computer operating  
7 system.

8 **Sec. 5.** Any remaining balance of the appropriations made by  
9 sections 1 to 4, inclusive, of this act must not be committed for  
10 expenditure after June 30, 2025, by the entity to which the  
11 appropriation is made or any entity to which money from the  
12 appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in any manner, and  
13 any portion of the appropriated money remaining must not be spent  
14 for any purpose after September 19, 2025, by either the entity to  
15 which the money was appropriated or the entity to which the money  
16 was subsequently granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the  
17 State General Fund on or before September 19, 2025.

18 **Sec. 6.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
