AN ACT making appropriations to the State Department of Agriculture for the replacement of computer hardware and associated software and deferred maintenance projects; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

# THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General 2 Fund to the Division of Animal Industry of the State Department of 3 Agriculture the sum of \$12,260 for the replacement of computer 4 hardware and associated software.

5 **Sec. 2.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General 6 Fund to the Division of Administrative Services of the State 7 Department of Agriculture the sum of \$192,478 for deferred 8 maintenance projects.

9 Sec. 3. Any remaining balance of the appropriations made by 10 sections 1 and 2 of this act must not be committed for expenditure 11 after June 30, 2025, by the entity to which the appropriation is made 12 or any entity to which money from the appropriation is granted or





otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the
appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose
after September 19, 2025, by either the entity to which the money
was appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently
granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General
Fund on or before September 19, 2025.

7 Sec. 4. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
