AN ACT making an appropriation to the Division of Water Resources of the State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources for a study of extreme rainfall events; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State
2 General Fund to the Division of Water Resources of the State
3 Department of Conservation and Natural Resources the sum of
4 \$650,000 for a study of extreme rainfall events, including, without
5 limitation, a study of the annual exceedance probability.
6 2. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by
7 subsection 1 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30,
8 2025, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or any entity
9 to which money from the appropriation is granted or otherwise
10 transferred in any manner, and any portion of the appropriated
11 money remaining must not be spent for any purpose after
12 September 19, 2025, by either the entity to which the money was
13 appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently



1 granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General
2 Fund on or before September 19, 2025.

3 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
