**AN ACT** making a supplemental appropriation to the Office of the Secretary of State for an unanticipated shortfall related to credit card processing fees; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1     **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
- 2 Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State the sum of \$426,376 for
- 3 an unanticipated shortfall related to credit card processing fees. This
- 4 appropriation is supplemental to that made by section 5 of chapter
- 5 310, Statutes of Nevada 2021, at page 1801.
- 6     **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
