THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the Division of Forestry of the State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources the sum of \$15,132,620 for an unanticipated shortfall related to firefighting costs. This appropriation is supplemental to that made by section 23 of chapter 310, Statutes of Nevada 2021, at page 1808.
