

SENATE BILL NO. 494—COMMITTEE ON FINANCE

SUMMARY—Makes appropriations to and authorizes the expenditure of money by the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy of the Department of Health and Human Services for the replacement or purchase of computer hardware and software, a certain database and a centralized credentialing process. (BDR S-1183)

AN ACT making appropriations to and authorizing the expenditure of money by the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy of the Department of Health and Human Services for the replacement or purchase of computer hardware and software, a database for surveillance and utilization review and a centralized credentialing process; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State
2 General Fund to the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy
3 of the Department of Health and Human Services the sum of
4 \$368,174 for the Health Care Financing and Policy Administration
5 budget account for the replacement and purchase of computer
6 hardware and associated software.



1 2. Expenditure of \$368,172 not appropriated from the State
2 General Fund or the State Highway Fund is hereby authorized
3 during Fiscal Year 2023-2024 and Fiscal Year 2024-2025 by the
4 Division of Health Care Financing and Policy of the Department of
5 Health and Human Services for the same purpose as set forth in
6 subsection 1.

7 **Sec. 2.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State
8 General Fund to the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy
9 of the Department of Health and Human Services the sum of
10 \$43,185 for the Health Care Financing and Policy Administration
11 budget account for the replacement of the database for surveillance
12 and utilization review.

13 2. Expenditure of \$388,670 not appropriated from the State
14 General Fund or the State Highway Fund is hereby authorized
15 during Fiscal Year 2023-2024 and Fiscal Year 2024-2025 by the
16 Division of Health Care Financing and Policy of the Department of
17 Health and Human Services for the same purpose as set forth in
18 subsection 1.

19 **Sec. 3.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State
20 General Fund to the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy
21 of the Department of Health and Human Services the sum of
22 \$160,000 for the Health Care Financing and Policy Administration
23 budget account for a centralized credentialing and re-credentialing
24 process.

25 2. Expenditure of \$1,440,000 not appropriated from the State
26 General Fund or the State Highway Fund is hereby authorized
27 during Fiscal Year 2023-2024 and Fiscal Year 2024-2025 by the
28 Division of Health Care Financing and Policy of the Department of
29 Health and Human Services for the same purpose as set forth in
30 subsection 1.

31 **Sec. 4.** Any remaining balance of the appropriations made by
32 sections 1, 2 and 3 of this act must not be committed for expenditure
33 after June 30, 2025, by the entity to which the appropriation is made
34 or any entity to which money from the appropriation is granted or
35 otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the
36 appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose
37 after September 19, 2025, by either the entity to which the money
38 was appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently
39 granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General
40 Fund on or before September 19, 2025.

41 **Sec. 5.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
