SB322 / BDR 43-934 is an act relating to crimes; revising the penalties for engaging in reckless driving under certain circumstances; and providing other matters.

Section 3 of this bill adds an additional breakout crime if the person engaging in reckless driving is traveling at a rate of speed that is 50 miles per hour or more over the posted limit.

If this bill as introduced is enacted, it would require the Department of Public Safety, Records Communications and Compliance Division (RCCD), Nevada Offense Code Unit (NOC) staff to create 6 NOCs and 6 sub-types. However, the cumulative impact of the legislation from the 2023 session will increase the volume of NOC revisions. The RCCD may request to return to the Interim Finance Committee in the 2023-2025 biennium should workload increases necessitate additional staffing.
