The Aging and Disability Services Division (ADSD) reviewed this bill draft request and determined that it will have a fiscal impact on the division. SB373, Section 1 as written would require ADSD to ensure vital documents are translated and made available in the most common 12 languages spoken by persons with limited English proficiency and report annually on vital documents accessibility. The bill would create a fiscal impact for document translations for programs directly carried out by ADSD.

To obtain the translation cost per word, ADSD reviewed the five MSA contracts and they ranged in price. An average of the cost was used given that multiple agencies throughout the State will be needing to access these vendors for translation services and ADSD cannot guarantee we will be able to obtain the vendor with the lowest cost. The MSA vendor cost sheets have a standard price and then pricing increases based on the turnaround time needed which can range upwards of \$.40 per word.

- (1) 50% of documents will be translated each year.
- (2) Estimated average word count of 3,000 words per document. Based on a sample of existing documents, referral/application forms average 2,284 words per document, eligibility documents 1,104 words, parent/participant handbooks and notices 8,169 words, and program brochures 1,015 words. Average of sampled documents was 3,143 words per document.
