The language of the bill is so broad that POST cannot determine the intent of the legislation and specifically in what circumstances a peace officer might be performing copyright material(s). Absent a clear understanding of the intent of the Bill, POST cannot accurately determine fiscal impacts or changes to training curriculum necessary to comply with the intent.
