SB405 / BDR 24-1090 is an act relating to elections; requiring, with certain exceptions, proof of identity for voting in person; authorizing a voter to request a mail ballot; establishing procedures relating to requesting a mail ballot; requiring a voter to include certain personal identifying information with his or her mail ballot; establishing certain requirements for a person who returns a mail ballot on behalf of a voter; providing penalties and other matters.

Sections 6, 15, 44, and 54 provide new crimes relating to election fraud.

If this bill as introduced is enacted, it would require the Department of Public Safety, Records Communications and Compliance Division (RCCD), Nevada Offense Code Unit (NOC) staff to create 12 NOCs, 12 sub-types. However, the cumulative impact of the legislation from the 2023 session will increase the volume of NOC revisions. The RCCD may request to return to the Interim Finance Committee in the 2023-2025 biennium should workload increases necessitate additional staffing.
