BDR 58-974; AB456 AN ACT relating to railroads; prohibiting the operation in this State of certain trains that are more than 7,500 feet long on certain; establishing provisions governing the duty hours of yardmasters; requiring a local authority or the Department of Transportation to install traffic-control devices and automated traffic enforcement systems at certain railroad grade crossings; providing civil penalties; establishing provisions governing the issuance of a civil infraction citation based on evidence detected by an automated traffic enforcement system; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.
