The Treasurer's Office ("the Office") has reviewed Assembly Bill 443 ("the Bill") and has determined that the Bill would expand the list of institutions eligible for utilization of funding for the Governor Guinn Millennium Scholarship awards. In regards to a potential increase in award costs, there is no mechanism to determine how many students eligible for the scholarship would choose not to attend under existing allowable institutions, but would choose to attend and utilize the award if such institutions as outlined in the Bill were allowable. In regards to administrative expenses, the Office does not believe the addition of these institutions would increase the cost of administrating the program and any additional administrative tasks required through the passage of the Bill could be absorbed by existing resources.
