SB404 / BDR 24-843 is an act relating to elections; authorizing, under certain circumstances, the Governor or Secretary of State to order changes to an election; making it unlawful for a person to disseminate certain information about an elections official; providing a penalty; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Section 3 makes it a crime for any person to disseminate any personal identifying information or sensitive information of an elections official without consent.

If this bill as introduced is enacted, it would require the Department of Public Safety, Records, Communications and Compliance Division (RCCD), Nevada Offense Code (NOC) Unit staff to create 3 NOCs and 3 subtypes. However, the cumulative impact of the legislation from the 2023 session will increase the volume of NOC revisions. The RCCD may request to return to the Interim Finance Committee in the 2023-2025 biennium should workload increases necessitate additional staffing.
