The provisions of Senate Bill No. 379 (SB379) would require the Nevada Gaming Control Board (Board) to adopt regulations for the operation and registration of secondary sports pool wagering brokers. The bill also required the Board to adopt regulations specifying the duties relating to the manufacture or repair of gaming devices, associated equipment, cashless wagering systems or interactive gaming systems that an employee must have for the employee to constitute a gaming employee. Finally, this bill requires a foreign gaming manufacturer to file with the Board certain annual reports, quarterly reports and other information required by the Commission. Being unaware of what the adopted regulation(s) would specifically require, the Board cannot determine what costs it would incur with secondary sports pool wagering brokers, manufacturers of gaming systems, and foreign gaming manufacturers.
