The agency has reviewed the bill and determined there is a negative fiscal impact in the 2023-2025 biennium and a positive fiscal impact on future biennia. Section 1 of the bill revises the required participation date for the Extended Youth Adult Support Services Program to July 1, 2025. The impact of moving the implementation to the next biennium results in a reduction to the Governor's Recommended budget by eliminating funding proposed in budget accounts 3141, 3142, 3229 in decision units E372 and E373 which fund both staff and foster care subsidies to begin implementation of this program.
