BDR 24-539 is an act relating to elections; prohibiting a person from conspiring to create or serve in a false slate of presidential electors; prohibiting the State or a local government from appointing to public office or employing a person convicted of such an offense; providing a penalty; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Section 1 of this bill prohibits a person from conspiring to create or serve in a false slate of presidential electors.

If this bill as introduced is enacted, it would require the Department of Public Safety, Records Communications and Compliance Division (RCCD), Nevada Offense Code Unit (NOC) staff to create 1 new NOC and 1 new subtype. However, the cumulative impact of the legislation from the 2023 session will increase the volume of NOC revisions. The RCCD may request to return to the Interim Finance Committee in the 2023-2025 biennium should workload increases necessitate additional staffing.
