Comment: The Board has approximately 47 pages of documents requiring translation into 12 languages. We estimate the cost to be \$40.05 per page based on an average of \$0.17 per word from WorldWide Interpreters, Inc. for their standard document translation services. For all twelve languages, the estimate is \$22,286.64. Approximately 15 pages are found on the Department of Public Safety's website. If DPS provided the translations of their documents for fingerprinting in the 12 languages, the cost would then be \$15,377.64. Once the initial translations are completed, the estimated cost would be for copies of the documents, only if an applicant or interested person wanted hard copies. PDFs can be emailed at no additional charge.

The cost for the translation of the Board website cannot be determined. The information explaining the application process is also contained in the applications themselves.

Comment: Subsections 1(a) and (b) of this bill would require our agency to provide each of our vital documents to the public in no less than 12 different languages. We are assuming the State will provide translation services for the content hosted on our State-maintained website. The remainder of our vital documents are license and renewal applications hosted on our own website, as well as related documents explaining our licensing requirements and attendant information. Therefore, we would need to translate and develop web versions of five separate applications and provide the attendant documents in 12 languages. We estimate the word count on all of our vital documents at 15,000 and the cost per word at 20 cents, times 11 additional languages, for a total cost of \$33,000 for the initial translation services. We would then have additional web development costs, which we are estimating at around \$15,000, as that was the approximate cost of setting up our current online applications. We would also have additional web hosting costs, which we estimate at around \$200 per month for the additional data storage. The costs of maintaining the new forms are difficult to estimate, as we don't know how often the forms and documents will need to be revised, so we are not including them in our calculations.

Comment: I took all the critical documents (pdf versions) and converted them to Microsoft Word. I did a word count for each one. The contracts that purchasing has established reflected between \$.10 and \$.30 per word so I chose the higher range and multiplied that by the 12 languages required for a total of \$74,278.80. For the additional biennial costs, I took an estimate of 20% of the applications we receive would need to be translated this came in at approximately \$44,863.20 per biennium.

Comment: • Our agency is refining its language access plan that came from 2021 legislation. Besides translating vital documentation into 12 languages, we know that the agency will need to utilize on-demand interpretation services. This is because the translated forms will cause non-English speaking phone calls to increase in volume. This assumption is because non-English speakers are currently asking their family, friends to translate and get their questions answered. Once we have translated, accessible documentation, we believe that we will be expected to provide on-demand translation services. Re: translation of vital documentation, the plan assumes that the agency will translate these according to a standardize time as per contract (i.e., not expedited); and

- o Assuming a per page language translation @ per word rate are between @ \$ .10 /word to \$ .30 / word for source documents: and
- o Approximately 9,000 words of source documentation information are currently being accessed in English through paper forms and online; and
- o We expect to require translation of 75% of source documentation from one language to another for an approximate total of 6,750 words at an average of \$ .20 per word for a total of \$1350 multiplied by 12 languages for a grand total of \$16,200; and
- o Assuming a need for on-demand interpreting e.g., answering questions about the translated documents shall cost between \$ 1.64 /min. \$1.95 /min for most requested languages; and assuming the Board would receive approximately 25 175 calls per month for interpretation services at 30 minutes per call, we approximate that costs for on-demand interpreting will be on average \$1.75 /min. x 30 min x average of 100 calls would total \$5250.00 annually; and
- Equipment will have one-time costs of approximately \$445; and
- That taking SB373 through our related NAC changes via LCB and related costs will be approximately \$2500.

As introduced this bill will have a significant fiscal impact on the agency. The agency reviewed vital information and performed an analysis based on the word count of each critical document. Estimated fiscal impacts were determined using an average of the contracts approved for translation services by State Purchasing.

Specifically the section that requires the Boards information be made available in 12 different languages. In reviewing the critical documents of the Board and the contracts that State purchasing has established for translation services is approximately \$.10 to \$.30 per word multiplied by 12 different languages it would require a cost of approximately \$34,000 to implement this change. It should only affect the fiscal year that the requirement goes into affect. Unless additional changes are made to future biennia.

Comment: Using the written translation service contracts available through State Purchasing, the cost averages \$0.20 per word. The Optometry Board's critical documents for translation would include how to verify a license and submit a complaint, as well as information about its various application instructions and licensing requirements. Using Microsoft Word software to complete a word count, the Board estimates those documents contain 33,505 words at \$0.20, multiplied by 10 languages for a total cost of \$6,701.00.

Future costs would be incurred to update these materials as the information changes, estimated at 20% of the total each year. Typically legislation is adopted and is effective in odd-numbered years and regulatory changes typically take effect in even-numbered years. In addition, additional website work and server space may be required to make those documents available online through the agency's website, at a cost of \$400 per year.

Comment: I took the cost of translation from 0.13 cents per word for official translation (it can be more or less depending on the language, but this is about average). I then multiplied the cost per word by the average word count on my documents that I consider 'vital' (apps, renewals, bulletins/newsletter, consumer complaint forms-instructions, agendas, minutes, etc.) then multiply by 12 for each language. At 500 words per page at 0.13 cents for 12 languages, that would be \$780 per page.. Carry that over annually (because due to legislative and regulation changes, we update our apps/renewals annually plus ongoing costs of the agenda/minutes, that's where I would ball park costs at being totaled.

We have initially determined that the following languages are the top 12 languages needed to be translated from English to following: Spanish, Vietnamese, French, German, Russian, Korean, Tagalog, Arabic, Portuguese, Japanese, Polish, and Chinese. This bill would require translation of approximately thirty-five (35) documents with about 17,450 words for an initial costs ranging from approximately a low of \$21,000.00 to a high of \$63,000.00. This initial estimation does not include any cost estimates regarding computer programming changes. Thank you.
