DETR has reviewed BDR 18-1 / SB143 1st Reprint and determined that fiscal impact remains as related to an increase caseload for

investigations by the Nevada Equal Rights Commission. DETR believes that the agency would require one additional Compliance Investigator II position to address the increased caseload, as well as a full time Staff Attorney with a supporting Legal Assistant II based on the requirements of section 15 to support AG efforts to prosecute on behalf of claimants and stand in for quick eviction hearings. Due to supervision of a staff attorney in the Nevada Equal Rights Commission, DETR also believes there would be costs associated with an increase in the salary of the NERC Administrator to supervise and support the staff attorney.
