The Nevada Department of Corrections (NDOC) has reviewed Senate Bill 105 which makes proposed revisions to Section 1 of NRS 233B.039, Section 2 of NRS 209.221, and Section 3 of NRS 209.2473 which would remove the exemption, for the most part, of the department from the Nevada Administrative Procedure Act. Section 4 of the bill states that Department shall, as soon as practicable, adopt regulations to replace the Administrative Regulations previously approved by the Board of State Prison Commissioners.

NDOC believes a fiscal impact will be realized including, but not limited to, costs for the review of the proposed regulations by the Office of the Attorney General and the Legislative Counsel Bureau and costs associated with conducting public workshops and hearings. However, at this time, the department, is unable to determine the amount of and in which fiscal year those costs would occur.
