Fiscal impact is not anticipated at this time by DHCFP. This bill directs certain publicly funded programs to provide treatment of alcohol or other SUDs, defines certain prescribing requirements for offenders or prisoners who have been diagnosed with an OUD to MAT and the continuation of treatment upon release or transfer, prohibits certain discrimination, and defines certain prescribing requirements for treatment for those with OUD. This bill does not direct Medicaid to reimburse for SUD/OD treatment outside of what is currently allowable for Medicaid eligible recipients.
