The agency has reviewed the the bill and determined that there is no fiscal impact on expenses. The agency conducted further review regarding revenues and determined fiscal impact cannot be determined as discussed below.

Section 11: Existing law in NRS 445A.145.2-3 allows for collection of a fee for loans or other financial assistance from the Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF). The State Environmental Commission adopted regulations in 1990 limiting that fee to 0.5% of the loan amount (NAC 445A.775). In recent fiscal years, this revenue has varied from \$0 - \$455,000. AB20 expands "eligible recipients" and projects for the CWSRF. NDEP cannot estimate the number or amount of future loans; therefore, the fiscal effect of AB20 on an increase to program revenue, above existing fees, cannot be determined.
