BDR 49-608 is an act relating to pest control; establishing provisions governing the issuance of a provisional license as an applicator to engage in pest control; requiring the Director of the State Department of Agriculture to establish a fee for the issuance of such a provisional license; providing a penalty; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

If this bill is enacted as introduced, it would require the Department of Public Safety, Records Communications and Compliance Division (RCCD), Fingerprint Examiner Unit (FEU) and the Civil Fingerprint Support Unit (FSU) to process the fingerprints provided. FEU and FSU may experience a minimal increase in fingerprints to be processed. However, the cumulative impact of the legislation from the 2023 biennium session may increase overall fingerprint submissions. The RCCD may request to return to the Interim Finance Committee in the 2023-2025 biennium should workload increases necessitate additional staffing.
