LVMPD doesn't maintain an easily retrievable record of how many instances it cannot technically make an arrest due to a report of DV being filed, but after the 24-hour window has elapsed, thus incremental arrests (and subsequent detention and court cases) cannot be quantified. Additionally, cannot easily quantify the incremental arrests that would be made for "attempts" in Section 5 of the bill, though the bill would likely result in additional charges, detentions, and court cases (and potential increased staffing requirements). The imprisonment length changes have no impact to the County (only State).
