BDR 43-256 SB66 Section 4 of this bill enacts prohibitions on employers which are similar to the prohibitions set forth in those federal 49 regulations. Section 9 provides for new railroad crossing regulations of commercial motor vehicles.

If this bill as introduced is enacted, it would require the Department of Public Safety, Records Communications and Compliance Division (RCCD), Nevada Offense Code Unit (NOC) staff to modify 4 existing NOCs and create two new criminal traffic NOCs. However, the cumulative impact of the legislation from the 2023 session will increase the volume of NOC revisions. The RCCD may request to return to the Interim Finance Committee in the 2023-2025 biennium should workload increases necessitate additional staffing.
