AB154 / BDR 40-455 is an act relating to tissue donation; requiring the State Board of Health to regulate the living donation of birth tissue; requiring an organization that processes birth tissue to be certified; providing a penalty; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Section 2 makes it a felony to violate the regulations of the Board or to act as a private umbilical cord and placental tissue bank or other organization that processes birth tissue without such certification.

If this bill as introduced is enacted, it would require the Department of Public Safety, Records Communications and Compliance Division (RCCD), Nevada Offense Code Unit (NOC) staff to create 3 new NOCs and 3 new subtypes. However, the cumulative impact of the legislation from the 2023 session will increase the volume of NOC revisions. The RCCD may request to return to the Interim Finance Committee in the 2023-2025 biennium should workload increases necessitate additional staffing.
