Comment: DETR has reviewed BDR 7-405 and determined that there is fiscal impact related to personnel time and contract development time to comply with the requirements of the bill. This bill would require that agencies with whom businesses must register to legally conduct business in the state integrate such registration through the Secretary of State's business portal. For DETR, this would involve integration of businesses' registration to pay the Unemployment Insurance Contributions tax.

DETR is currently working with a vendor to replace the legacy Unemployment Insurance system, and estimates that it would take an additional 480 hours of change request time from the vendor, whose change request rate is \$190/hour. Additionally, it is expected that there would be approximately 240 additional hours of testing and troubleshooting for the portal by staff. DETR therefore estimates that there would be a cost of \$91,200 related to the contract developers of the new UI system, and an additional \$9,682 of personnel costs for a Business Process Analyst to test and troubleshoot.
