SB243 / BDR 15-37 is an act relating to catalytic converters; prohibiting certain acts relating to used catalytic converters under certain circumstances; establishing requirements relating to transactions involving used catalytic converters; providing penalties; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Sections 2 - 4 provides for new crimes relating to catalytic convertors. Section 15 provides for new escalating penalties for certain misdemeanor crimes relating to catalytic convertors.

If this bill as introduced is enacted, it would require the Department of Public Safety, Records Communications and Compliance Division (RCCD), Nevada Offense Code Unit (NOC) staff to create 10 new NOCs and 10 new subtypes and modify 1 NOC. However, the cumulative impact of the legislation from the 2023 session will increase the volume of NOC revisions. The RCCD may request to return to the Interim Finance Committee in the 2023-2025 biennium should workload increases necessitate additional staffing.
