AB263 / SB 40-125 is an act relating to water; enacting provisions relating to the transmission of Legionnaires' disease by certain building water systems in covered health care facilities; providing a penalty; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

This bill adds a new section to NRS 441A establishing certain requirements for the building water systems in covered health care facilities to limit the risk of the transmission of Legionnaires' disease; any violation, unless otherwise provided is a misdemeanor.

If this bill as introduced is enacted, it would require the Department of Public Safety, Records Communications and Compliance Division (RCCD), Nevada Offense Code Unit (NOC) staff to modify 4 NOCs. However, the cumulative impact of the legislation from the 2023 session will increase the volume of NOC revisions. The RCCD may request to return to the Interim Finance Committee in the 2023-2025 biennium should workload increases necessitate additional staffing.
