It has been determined that as currently drafted AB 253 (BDR 56-152), will have an impact on the Cannabis Compliance Board (CCB).

This fiscal note adds 13 full-time positions to the CCB to assist with the new regulatory and enforcement duties as a result of the provisions in the bill. It is difficult to determine the actual number of events in Nevada. However, based on Travel Nevada (https://travelnevada.com/events/?start-date=2023-07-01&end-date=2024-06-30) there are approximately 73 events on the calendar from July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024, which could potentially attract cannabis vendors. Actual license and registrations are yet to be determined.

Revenue impacts were not included in the attached fiscal note due to the uncertainty around licensing and event fees which are to be decided by the CCB through regulation at a future date.
