 Comment: Washoe County has previously received State funding for the purchase of mechanical voting systems and mechanical recording devices. Washoe County continues to use such equipment with support of the Washoe County Board of County Commissioners. However, the decision regarding ongoing use of such equipment remains with the Washoe County Board of County Commissioners and at any point in the future they could determine that they wish to discontinue the use of mechanical voting systems and/or mechanical recording devices (other than a mechanical voting system or mechanical recording device required pursuant to NRS 293.2955 for a voter who is elderly or a voter with a disability). Under the provisions of this BDR, any such decision would require reimbursement to the State for any mechanical equipment and mechanical recording devices purchased using State funds. Because it is unknown if the Washoe County Board of County Commissioners will make such a decision or not, the fiscal effect of this BDR cannot be determined.
