BDR 24-894 is a bill relating to elections and would revise provisions concerning: making it unlawful to use force, retaliate or threaten an elections official in the performance of their duties and disseminate information about such officials; authorize certain employees to request their information be kept confidential, and; allow such persons to request that the DMV display an alternate address on their driver's licenses and identification cards; and also provides certain penalties. This bill becomes effective upon passage and approval.

The Department has reviewed this bill and determined there will be no impact as currently written. DMV already has procedures in place for requesting display of alternate addresses and this bill's provisions would be incorporated into that existing process.
